Executive Summary

LCCI Global Qualifications delivered a 16-day Student Mobility Programme for Forth Valley College, Scotland, UK, from 31 January to 15 February 2026. The programme united 15 international participants (12 students, 3 mentors) with 11 BBA students from AITM College, Nepal, across four destinations: Lalitpur, Kathmandu, Chitwan, and Pokhara.

Programme Title:

“An Expedition into Business Learning, Cultural Understanding & Personal Development”

Participants described the experience as “life-changing”, “thought-provoking”, and “very spiritual”.

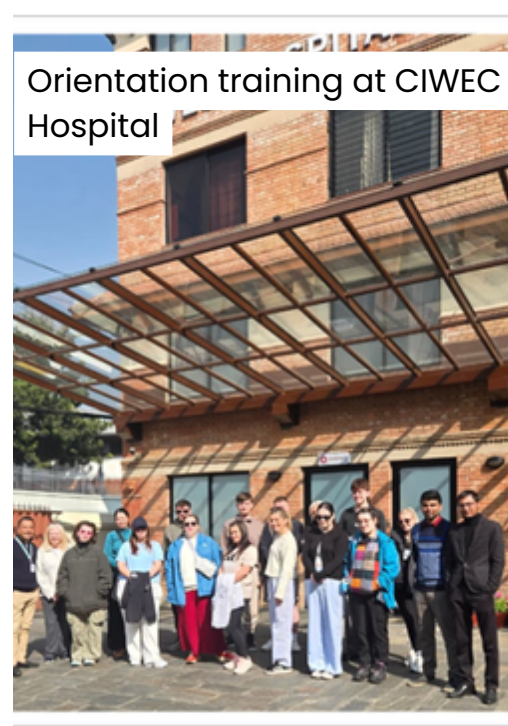
Programme Structure & Phases

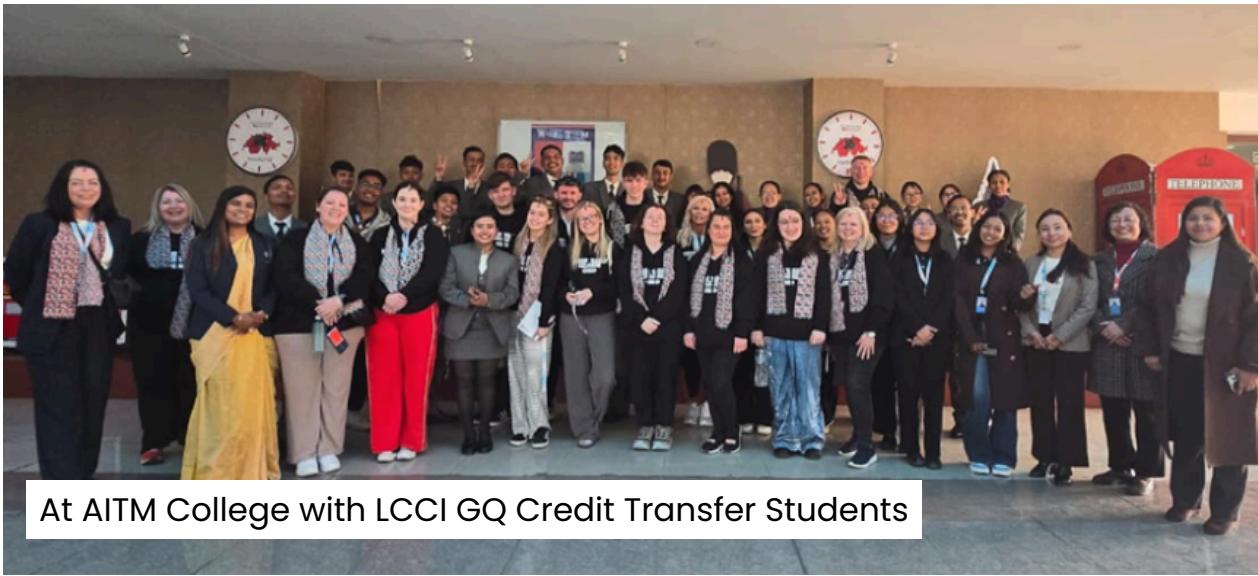

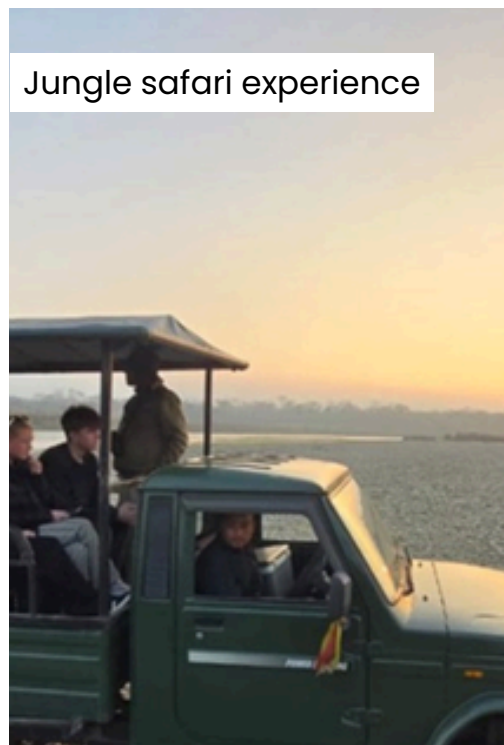


